Canine Bed Bug Scent Detection Inspection Preparation List

It has come to our attention that there is bed bug activity in this building. We have contracted with Global Pest Control to treat this situation.

The first step in treating and controlling this insect population, is a canine inspection. We have scheduled a mandatory inspection of all units. This is pursuant to the NYC Health Code §151.02, which requires management to inspect all units adjacent to apartments found to be positive for bed bugs. We as your management company would like to be pro-active and check the entire building.

Upon completion of this inspection, you will be notified if your unit is positive and treatment will be scheduled.

This treatment can only be successful with full tenant participation.

Please make sure you are available to give Global Pest Control access to your unit during the inspection. If you are not available at this time, make sure the super has your key to give access.

Preparation Checklist:

- Place all pets in the bathroom during the inspection.
 - All pet food, bedding and toys should be placed in a bag and put in the bathroom with the pet.
- There should be no food preparation or open food prior to the inspection.
- Air conditioning and fans should be left on.
- Windows should remain closed.
- No spraying of perfumes, air fresheners or plug-in type devices.
- No scented candles should be burned that day.
- No cleaning with chemicals the day of the inspection.
- Empty trash cans.

Non compliance can result in charges being passed on to each tenant.
