Thermal Remediation Prep List

This unit is scheduled to be treated for bed bugs with thermal remediation and will be subject to intense heat.

Please review this preparation list carefully, to assure optimal results of the treatment.
These items must be completed prior to the treatment start date.

- All of the following items in this section should be wiped down with Isopropyl Alcohol (this is stronger than rubbing alcohol).
 - These items can be placed in the refrigerator for the entire treatment process

Candles	Crayons
Aerosol cans / Fire Extinguishers	Carbonated beverages
Printer Cartridges	Cosmetics
Plants Flowers (vinyl and real)	Medication/Vitamins
Perishables	Wine bottles with corks/ Liquor
 - These items should be placed in a box at the front of the unit for inspection. The supervisor will provide further service instructions during the inspection

Vinyl records	VHS Tapes
Artwork	Cassette Tapes / CDs / DVDs
Antique books/ glued items	Antique furniture
- Remove any valuables from the unit
- Sleep number beds must be deflated
- All other items must remain in the unit, to be treated by the heat.
- If your alarm system is connected to a central station, please notify them to switch your system to "test mode" for the day
- All plastic / vinyl shades should be taken down and placed on the floor
- Once the treatment has started, there can be no people or animals in the unit
- Your clothing for the day may have bed bugs/eggs on them. To avoid re-introducing bed bugs to your unit, the following procedures should be followed for all residents of your unit:
 - Place one complete outfit of clothing in a bag by the front door of your unit.
 - This bag will be treated with heat while you are out of the unit.
 - Upon re-entering the unit, you will be asked to change into these clothing in a designated area.
 - The clothing you have now removed will be placed in a sealed bag and disposed. Please make sure the outfit you are wearing on the day of treatment is not important and can be discarded.

Please note the following:

- Due to the high temperature used during treatment, some vinyl wallpaper may peel off; although unlikely, it is possible.
- We will be removing the mattresses and box springs from the bed frame.
- We will be opening all drawers, dressers and closets and treating as follows:
 - If they are not overly cluttered items will remain in their place for treatment
 - If they are determined to be too full for successful treatment, items will be removed and placed in baskets for treatment.
 - This will be done to allow the heat to penetrate all potential harborage areas.
